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Resolution Adopting Personnel Policies and Procedures

WHEREAS, it is the policy of Englewood Housing Authority to treat employees and prospective employees in a manner consistent with all applicable employment laws and regulations including, but not limited to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended by the Equal Opportunity Act of 1972, the Age Discrimination in Employment Act, the Equal Pay for Equal Work Act, the Fair Labor Standards Act, the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Family and Medical Leave Act, the Conscientious Employee Protection Act, the Public Employee Occupational Safety and Health Act, (the New Jersey Civil Service Act,) (the New Jersey Attorney General's guidelines with respect to Police Department personnel matters,) the New Jersey Workers Compensation Act, the Federal Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA) and the Open Public Meeting Act; and

WHEREAS, the Englewood Housing Authority has determined that there is a need for personnel policies and procedures to ensure that employees and prospective employees are treated in a manner consistent with these laws and regulations.

NOW, THEREBY, BE IT RESOLVED by the Englewood Housing Authority that the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual attached hereto is hereby adopted with the following extensive changes:

- · American with Disability Act Policy (page 5)
- · Telephone Usage Policy (page 21)
- · Communication Media/Social Media Policy (page 22)
- · Use of Internet (page 26)
- · Employee Dating policy (page 27)
- · Background Checks & Procedures for Candidates, Employees & Volunteers (page 41)
- Open Public Meeting Act Procedure Concerning Personnel Matters (page 44)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these personnel policies and procedures shall apply to all Englewood Housing Authority officials, appointees, employees, volunteers and independent contractors. In the event there is a conflict between these rules and any collective bargaining agreement, personnel services contract or Federal or State law, the terms and conditions of that contract or law shall prevail. In all other cases, these policies and procedures shall prevail.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this manual is intended to provide guidelines covering public service by the Englewood Housing Authority employees and is not a contract. The provisions of this

manual may be amended and supplemented from time to time without notice and at the sole discretion of the housing authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the maximum extent permitted by law, employment practices for the Englewood Housing Authority shall operate under the legal doctrine known as "employment at will."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director and all managerial/supervisory personnel are responsible for these employment practices. The Executive Director and the Housing Authority attorney shall assist the Executive Director in the implementation of the policies and procedures in this manual.
