## **Report of the Executive Director**

The Englewood Housing Authority's first annual Super Bowl party for the residents of Tibbs was a success -- approximately 25 residents participated. In addition to the food and drink provided by EHA, residents also brought items to share with their neighbors.

At Westmoor Gardens, EHA has begun the replacement of 16 kitchens (including cabinets, countertops, sinks, faucet, painted backsplashes, etc.). The majority of the materials were purchased in 2018 as part of the capital expenditure plan. Installation is being performed by staff via overtime on weekends at a rate of one kitchen per weekend. The total labor cost for the installation is approximately \$800-\$1,000 per kitchen.

On Tuesday, March 26<sup>th</sup>, EHA will hold a Town Hall-style meeting at City Hall to educate the residents of Englewood about our various programs. The PowerPoint presentation will be provided to the Commissioners prior to the event for your review and comment.
